The 7th Annual Build Northwest Awards program is approaching. This is your chance to be recognized for your outstanding achievements.

Awards will be presented during the Inland Northwest AGC's Annual Convention on February 3, 2012 at the Davenport Hotel.

The 2011 Build Northwest Awards

The AGC's Build Northwest Awards honor AGC members who build the region's most impressive construction projects in a variety of sectors and project sizes. Judged by a panel of project-neutral peers, winners will be selected based on project uniqueness, innovation and overall job excellence, among other criteria. Winners will be recognized during a special Awards Luncheon at the Annual AGC Convention. So, put your best to the test and enter your projects today!

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The competition is open to all current dues-paying members of the Inland Northwest AGC for projects completed between November 1, 2010 and November 1, 2011. All parties of a joint venture **MUST** be AGC member firms.

Nominations must be submitted by principals or officers of firms, or with their permission. Different phases or elements of the same project may be entered independently, but not combined as another total project entry.

All projects must be located within the Inland Northwest region (Eastern Washington, North Idaho, Northeast Oregon and Western Montana.) A new category has been added this year for projects outside this region.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All entries must be submitted in both electronic and print format. See Required Submission Format for details. Upon receipt, award entries become sole property of the Inland Northwest AGC and will not be returned to the entrant.

ENTER TODAY!

The project you are working on right now may be a winner! **All entries must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 9, 2011**

REQUIRED MATERIALS & CONTENT

1. **Completed entry form.** (Please use original form or fill out electronic entry form available on the AGC website (www.nwagc.org) and print out for inclusion in submission)
2. **Completed project profile sheet.**
3. A **one-page summary** describing WHY the project should receive a Build Northwest Award.
4. A narrative explaining HOW the entry meets each of the following criteria (*with two or three paragraphs on each; no more than five pages total*):
 - Meeting the challenge of a difficult job
 - Excellence in project management: Was partnering utilized, value engineering proposals developed, etc.?
 - Contractor's innovation in construction techniques or materials
 - Contractor's state-of-the-art advancement
 - Contractor's sensitivity to the environment and surroundings, including Green Building techniques
 - Excellence in client service
 - Contractor's contribution to the community: What did you do as a contractor to reach out to the community to provide unique or special contributions? (Examples could include: Project tours for the community, barbecues provided for community and workers, parks built to invite the community into the project and special efforts made to accommodate persons with disabilities.) Did the project receive positive media exposure?
 - Company safety performance on project.

REQUIRED SUBMISSION FORMAT

PACKAGING: All entries **must be submitted in both electronic and print format.** Print version must be submitted on white paper with no images in the background on pages with text. They may be bound or unbound, but easily removable for photocopying. Electronic versions must be sent on CD in addition to your hard copy. Electronic version must include entry forms, summary, narratives and photos. A .pdf version of the submittal is preferred, but not required.

PHOTOS: Entries must include color photos. Photos should highlight the construction process and the finished product, including special techniques or unique conditions. High resolution photos must also be submitted on CD (this will be used for production purposes).

SUPPLEMENTALS: Entries may also include: slides; videos (*of no more than eight minutes*); media coverage; letters of recommendation; and other supplementary materials. DVD/CDs of projects are very helpful for judges to get a feel for the finished project and the work that went into the process.

Put Your **Best** To The Test

PROJECT CATEGORIES

Awards will be considered for new construction and renovation work in the categories of:

Building — Your completed project is a traditional building that may include office buildings, hospitals, schools, libraries, museums, multifamily housing and others. There will be two award categories for building:

- Under \$10 million
- \$10 million and over

Highway & Transportation - Your completed project included highways, bridges, airports, lane expansions, interchange improvements, new interchanges or alignments, overpasses, pedestrian bridges, road tunnels, transit and railroad projects.

Heavy & Utilities - Your completed project was related to water and wastewater, underground utility, site preparation and other types of public works construction such as public facilities, gas, water, sewer or electrical; any type of marine construction or dredging projects for ports and inland waterways; flood control and prevention projects; or any industrial plant construction.

Sub-Contractor - Your company was not the prime contractor on the project. The entire project does not need to be completed to submit your portion of the project for an award.

Supplier - Suppliers play a significant role in the completion of a successful project. The entire project does not need to be completed to submit your portion of the project for an award.

Out of Area - Your project was completed outside the Inland Northwest AGC territory as defined in the General Requirements. This category will include all types of construction.

Small Projects - Your completed project costs totaled less than \$2 million. This category will include all types of construction and is limited to General Contractors only.

Special Projects — Your completed project does not qualify under one of the above categories.
